

A Magnetic Tool Bit Holder for your Power Drill.

One that works!

Probably like you, I have often been irritated trying to snap tool bits back into their holders located on the typical hand drill. Or to find that the bit you want is not there - as sometimes there are only 1 or 2 bit-holders.

One solution I found is to modify a "Magnetic Hook" shown to the right, and then glue it upside-down on the base of the electric drill.

These hooks have a strong magnet inside. I found them at Princess Auto on a card of 10 pcs., p/n 8326746.

First unscrew and discard the hook, then check the



fit of the upside-down magnet cup on the base of your drill. If needed, you can drill out or pull off the threaded stud for a better fit.

Now use epoxy cement or "Marine Goop" to secure the magnet cup in place.

Cure over night and you are done!

I've found I can get 5 bits on it it easily and they don't fall off.

An added benefit is that the bits become do strongly magnetized and make holding steel screws on the end of the bit a lot easier!
